

Policy JFCA: STUDENT DRESS CODE

It is important for the district to provide an education environment that is safe and welcoming to all students and free from disruption. To further these goals, building principals will establish student dress codes for all grade levels that meet the district's goals and legal requirements. The superintendent or designee will establish dress code procedures to guide building principals in formulating building-level rules. The board authorizes the superintendent or designee to consult the district's attorney for guidance on legal issues.

Goals

The student dress code(s) must align with the district's goals, which include, but are not limited to:

1. Promoting health and safety;
2. Preventing student distraction and disruption to the learning environment;
3. Teaching students civility and tolerance of others;
4. Preparing students for the workplace and other places where dress is regulated;
5. Protecting students from drug and alcohol advertisements and vulgar, indecent, and obscene pictures and language.
